As a pet owner, you'll be happy to know that Incline Village is a pet-friendly community that offers a variety of resources to help you care for your furry friends. Many local dog owners refer to Tahoe as Doggie Disneyland. Plenty of kittens and cats live here too!

It is important to be aware of the local rules and regulations regarding pets to ensure you and your pets have a safe and enjoyable experience. Washoe County laws mandate that all dogs 4+ months and older are licensed and that dogs must be properly contained and/or restrained at all times with the exception of designated off-leash areas. Be aware that coyotes roam the area all year long. Small pets should not be left outdoors unsupervised, even with fencing.

The extensive trail systems in and surrounding Incline Village offer plenty of off-leash opportunities, and there are a few sanctioned opportunities for Fido to run in and around Incline Village:

- Village Green Dog Park
- Burnt Cedar Beach (October 15 - May 15)
- East Shore Trail (surface gets very hot during the Spring and Summer)
- Sand Harbor State Park (October 15 - May 15)
- Incline Flume Trail
- Tunnel Creek Trail
- Spooner Lake
- Mount Rose Meadows
